國際化已成為全球學術機構及大學院校的當務之急。他們以招收國際師生、簽署交流計劃、組織國際會議及合作等方式，鼓勵並支持國際化。在國際化方面的績效，會受到政府教育部門或世界大學排名所評估。然而，這並不是史上頭一遭。事實上，中世紀初期的大學，就已經胸懷國際主義的理想。但自 1990 年代迄今的這一波全球化浪潮，以及上一波浪潮（1880-1914），卻帶來了與以往截然不同的現象。舉例而言，1880-1914 年的全球化，將五大洲的學者及學生帶到了歐洲。而晚近的這一波全球化，則將國際學生的數量推至為數百萬的高峰，同時也將大量學生引向所謂的「南方世界」（Global South）。

本次會議是對歷史上高等教育的國際化，尤其是 1880-1914 以及 1990 至今的兩次全球化浪潮期間的比較考察。本次會議將從多個角度處理國際化議題：包括研究、課程、學者及學生流動、研究生培訓，以及國際會議等。討論範圍會涵蓋世界所有主要地區：包括歐洲、美國、俄羅斯、中東、拉丁美洲、印度，以及東亞（中國、韓國、日本及臺灣）。

Internationalization has become an imperative for academics and universities world-wide. They are encouraged and supported to internationalize: recruiting international faculty and students, signing exchange programs, organizing international conferences and collaborations, etc. They are evaluated by their ministries of education, or world university rankings, for their work on internationalization. This is not the first time universities do that. In fact universities started with an ideal of internationalism from the outset in the Middle Ages. But this wave of globalization, and the previous wave in 1880-1914, have brought about phenomena that are distinct from earlier ages. The globalization of 1880-1914 brought scholars and students from five continents to Europe, for example. The latest wave of globalization pushes the number of international students into the millions, and brings a significant number of students to the so-called Global South.

This conference is a comparative examination on the internationalization of higher education in history, especially during the two waves of globalization in 1880-1914 and 1990-present. It will approach internationalization from a variety of angles: research, curriculum, flows of scholars and students, graduate training, international conventions etc. It will cover all major areas of the world: Europe, the United States, Russia, the Middle East, Latin America, India, and East Asia (including China, and Korea, Japan and Taiwan).
